**From Boston and points North**

Take I-93 South which turns into I-95 (Route 128) North. Take Exit 15B, Route 1 South toward Norwood. Travel 4.5 miles, the Four Points by Sheraton Norwood. Hotel & Conference Center will be on your right after the Staples Plaza.

**From the West**

Follow Mass. Turnpike (I-90) East  
Take Exit 14 onto I-95 (Route 128) South. (Note: From the West, this Exit is number 14, from the East, it is number 15.)  
Continue South to Exit 15B. Route 1, Norwood, and proceed as above.

**From Providence, TF Green Airport & points South**

Take I-95 North to Exit 11B, Neponset Street, Norwood. Drive 7/10 of a mile and turn left onto Dean Street. At traffic light, turn left onto Route 1, heading South. The Four Points by Sheraton Norwood Hotel & Conference Center is on your right after the Staples Plaza.

**From Logan Airport**

Exit airport, follow signs through Williams tunnel (toll) to I-90 /I-93 South. Follow signs for I-93 South about 7 miles. I-93 South turns into I-95 (Route 128) North. Proceed on I-95(Route 128) North to Exit 15B, Route 1 Norwood. Travel Route 1 South 4.5 miles to the Four Points by Sheraton Norwood Hotel & Conference Center, located on your right after the Staples Plaza.
